Circus Arts Coach Position Description

The Circus Arts Instructor (Coach) is a member SANCA's coaching team and reports to the Assistant Program Director for training, work schedule and guidance. The purpose of the Coach is to provide an enjoyable and safe experience for an assigned group of students while they learn individual and group circus arts skills.

Coaching positions are currently part-time; you may teach as many hours as you are willing and able with the approval of the Program Director. This position qualifies for health insurance benefits if working 20 or more hours per week at SANCA. Must be available for special events and training.

Responsibilities:

Adhere to SANCA policies, objectives, and rules.

Coach an assigned group of children emphasizing skill development, safety, fair play, sportsmanship and fun

Work to establish and improve class unity

Ensure equal time on apparatus for all students

Ensure that students treat and maintain equipment appropriately

Obtain an appropriate and qualified substitute for your classes if you are unable to teach
